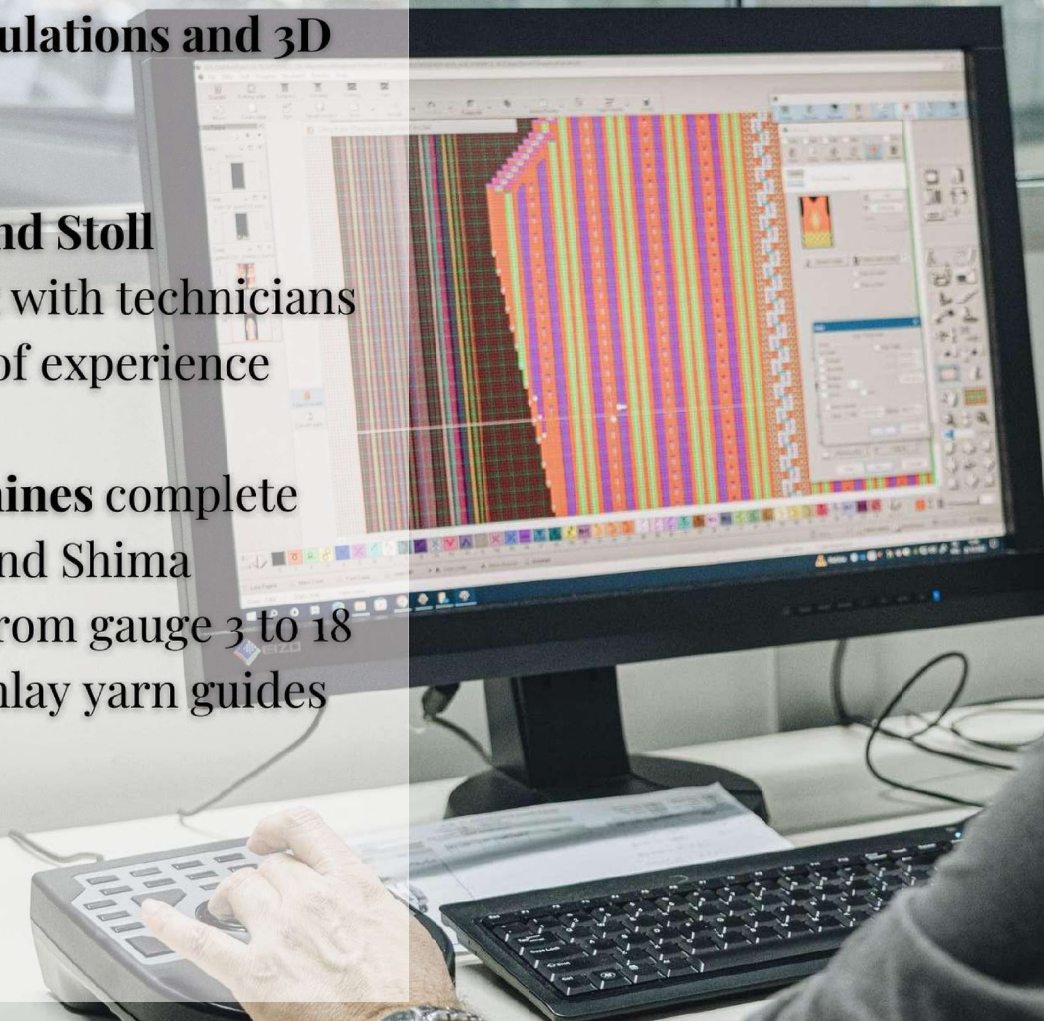

- **Prototyping department** with linkers and seamstresses with 20 years of experience
- **Tailoring department** dedicated to sampling and manufacturing with 20 employees and a modern and complete fleet of machines



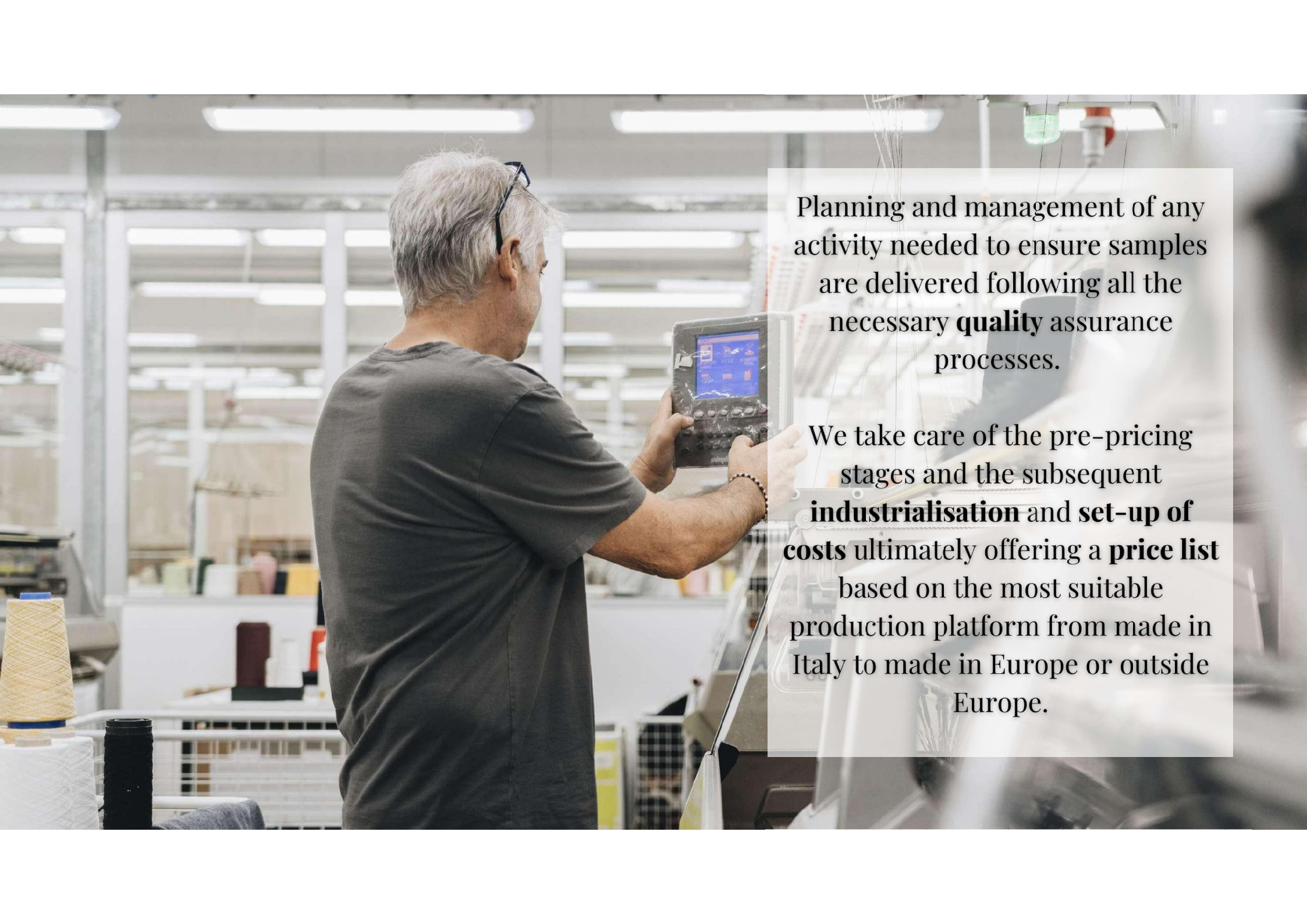
- **Laundry** for fulling garments with fine-tuning of the fulling recipe to make the most of each fibre and process

Fitting and sampling




Planning and management of any activity needed to ensure samples are delivered following all the necessary **quality** assurance processes.




Auditing and sustainability as a corporate commitment
